



How the Trader Support Service will work

One off registration

- Trader registers on TSS digital platform and provides required information

Data Submission

- The carrier submits shipment information to TSS. Information needed includes:
 - Transport ID
 - XI or EU EORI
 - Consignee, consignor, importer and exporter details
 - Transport document certificates
 - Mode of transport
 - Arrival/departure port
 - Weight, goods description, packaging description and count of individual packages within each declaration item
 - Shipping marks to identify items)
- TSS provides the carrier with an Entry Summary Declaration (ENS)

Frontier Declaration

- TSS processes a simplified frontier declaration (based on initial registration and ENS) on behalf of the trader

Transportation

- HMRC provides approval to move goods from GB to NI

Declaration Completion

- Trader provides additional shipment information to complete the frontier declaration. Information needed includes:
 - Country of origin, destination and dispatch
 - 10 digit import commodity code
 - Preference (e.g. whether preferential duty applies)
 - Valuation method and any supporting evidence e.g. commercial invoice document
 - Authorisation, licence or other document details as required

Evidence and Duty

- Trader maintains evidence and pays duties or claims subsidy on goods “at risk”
